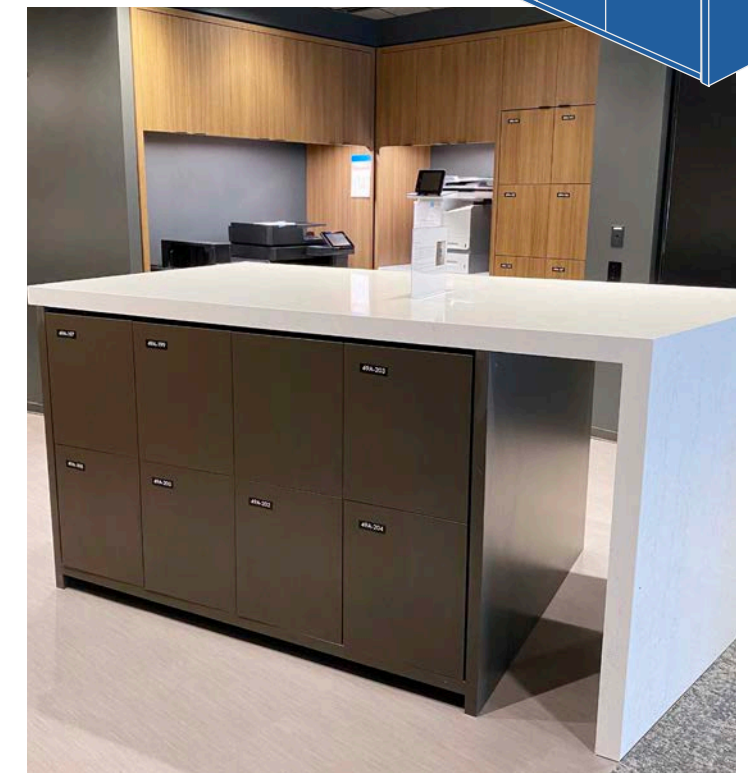
End Cap Lockers

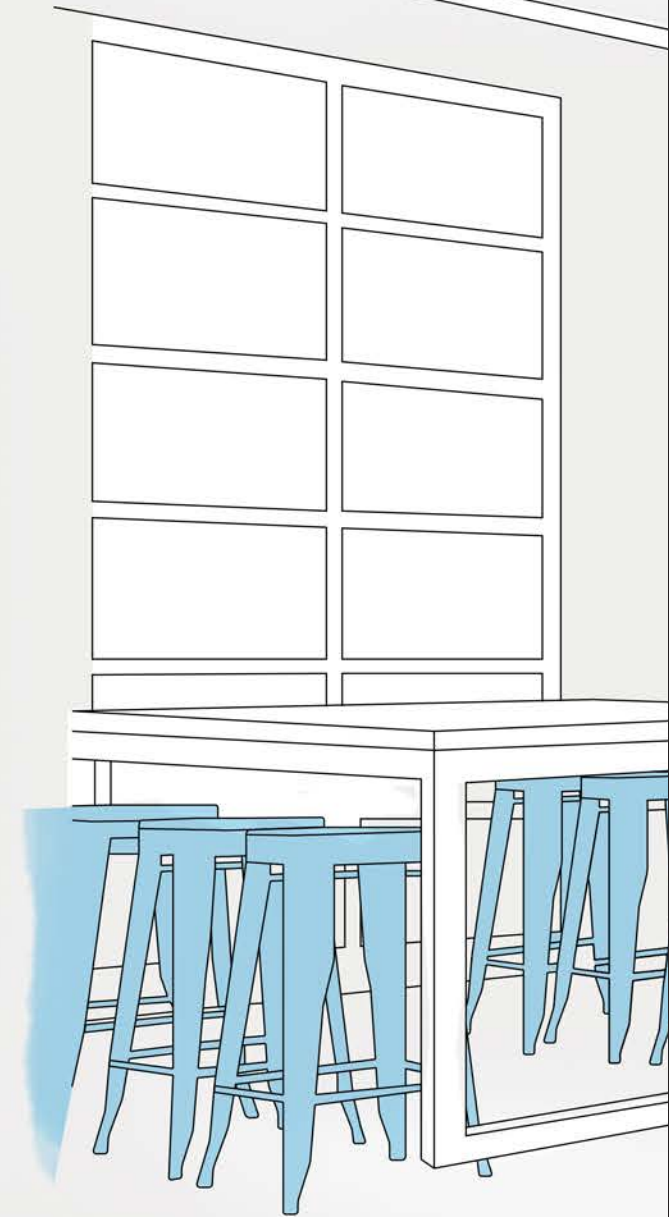
Zone Divider Lockers

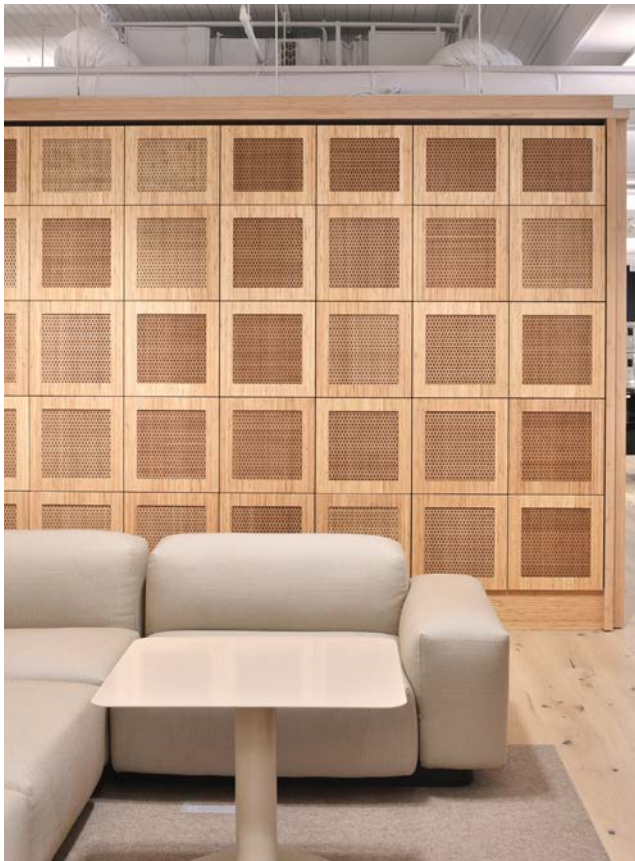

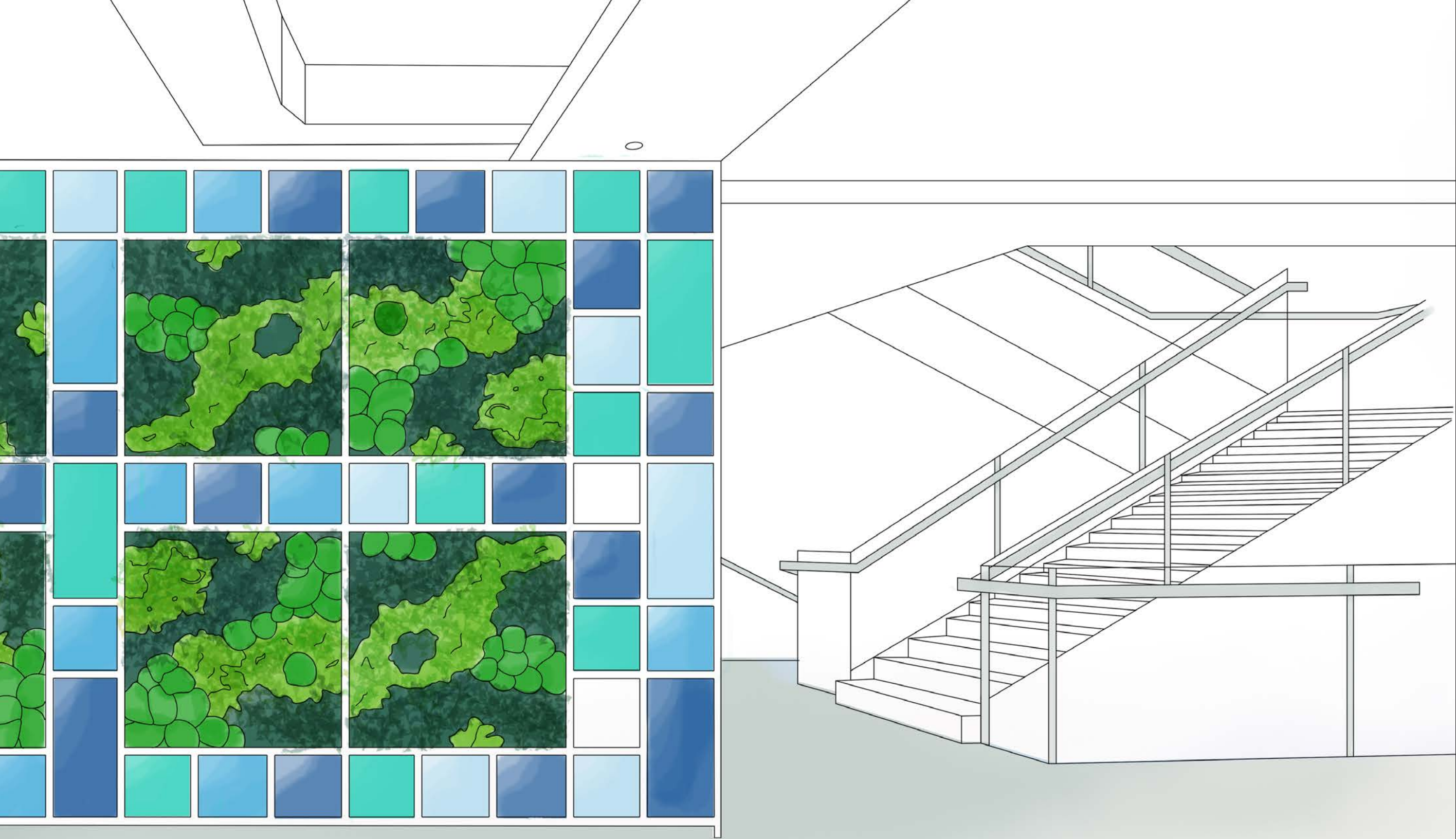
